It's a good idea to have some things prepared:

Home Emergency kit (suggested items)

- Copies of important documents
- Toiletries
- Prescription medication
- Glasses and hearing aids
- First aid kit
- Change of clothes
- Supplies for babies – food/drink/nappies
- Supplies for kids – food/drink/Small toy
- Torch (wind up or spare batteries)
- Food and bottled water for 3 days
- Radio (wind up or spare batteries)
- Foil blankets (1 per household member)
- Spare keys
- Mobile phone chargers
- Cash and credit cards
- Pet supplies (if needed)
