

STATEMENT OF REASONS

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, BLAGDON, WALTON-IN-GORDANO, WESTON-IN-GORDANO, BARROW GURNEY) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) **ORDER 2018**

North Somerset Council has introduced a number of 20mph and 30mph speed limits on various roads in Blagdon, Walton-in-Gordano Weston-in-Gordano and Barrow Gurney.

This order is for the purpose of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

In Weston-in-Gordano a 20mph limit has been created in the village centre, retaining the existing 30mph limits at each end of the village. Short sections of these 30mph limits do not require a traffic order as they are within a system of street lighting.

In Walton-in-Gordano a 20mph limit in the village centre has been created, retaining the 30mph limit heading north out of the village. The traffic order for the 30mph section has been revoked because of an incorrectly named road, and a new order with the correct name has been created.

In Blagdon a 20mph limit in the village centre has been created retaining the 30mph limit heading north west and south east out of the village. The traffic order for the 30mph sections have been revoked because of incorrectly named roads, and a new order with the correct names has been created.
