This Order is made by North Somerset District Council ("The Council") under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to North Somerset District Council that the County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District requires modification in consequence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act; namely that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsist or is reasonable alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The Council have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council hereby orders that:

- 1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 15 August 2017.
- 2. The County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Part of Footpath AX 29/48 and unrecorded route from Drove Way, Winscombe to Riverside, Banwell) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No.2 2017.

PART I

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of public right of way to be upgraded to a Bridleway

Modification of part of Footpath AX 29/48 to Bridleway AX 29/86

The footpath AX 29/48 commences from point A (Grid Ref: ST41176 61755) on the adopted highway known as Drove Way and proceeds in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 674 metres to point B (Grid Ref: ST40745 61235). This section of the route will be known as Bridleway AX 29/86.

Description of Bridleway to be added

The Unrecorded route commences from point B (Grid Ref: ST40745 61235) and proceeds in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 543 metres to point C (Grid Ref: ST40440 60790). This section of the route will be recorded as Bridleway AX 29/86.

The route then continues from point C (Grid Ref: ST40440 60790) and proceeds in a westerly direction, for a distance of approximately 571 metres to point D (Grid Ref: ST39874 60716), which ends at an adopted highway known as Riverside. This section of the route will be recorded as Bridleway AX 3/59.

This route will be in total an approximate length of 1788 metres and is shown on the attached map EB/Mod 51.



The above Order made on 31st August 2017, under Section 53 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 was confirmed by North Somerset Council on 11 May 2018.

The effect of the Order is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading to bridleway part of Footpath AX 29/48 to be known as Bridleway AX29/86 and the addition of a new bridleway to be known as AX29/86 and AX3/59. Bridleway AX 29/86 commences from point A (Grid Ref: ST41176 61755) on the adopted highway known as Drove Way and proceeds in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 674 metres to point B (Grid Ref: ST40745 61235). It then continues in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 543 metres to point C (Grid Ref: ST40440 60790). Bridleway AX 3/59 continues from point C (Grid Ref: ST40440 60790) and proceeds in a westerly direction, for a distance of approximately 571 metres to point D (Grid Ref: ST39874 60716), which ends at an adopted highway known as Riverside.

The Order came into force on 11 May 2018, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of Schedule 15 to the Act, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the Act, within six weeks from date on which the notice is first published, make an application to the High Court.
