

NOTICE OF INTENT

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL

CONSTRUCTION OF SPEED CUSHIONS AND RAISED TABLES ON STATION ROAD, BACKWELL, NORTH SOMERSET

1. NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of North Somerset in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C (1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 (hereinafter called 'the Regulations') and in accordance with section 90C (2) of the Act intends to construct road humps at the locations specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
2. **The general effect of the notice will be to construct raised tables and speed cushions on Station Road** at the following locations:
 - One raised table outside/near no.67 Station Road, grid ref: 348040,169133 approx. 4m in length.
 - One raised table outside/near no.63 Station Road, grid ref: 348073,169110 approx. 4m in length.
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.57 Station Road, grid ref: 348131,169083
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.49 Station Road, grid ref: 348210,169035
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.36 Station Road, grid ref: 348263,168992
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.39 Station Road, grid ref: 348345,168949
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.33 Station Road, grid ref: 348411,168895
 - Two speed cushions adjacent/near no.1 Westhaven Close on Station Road, grid ref: 348460,168848
 - Two speed cushions outside/near no.27 Station Road, grid ref: 348504,168803
 - One raised junction table from approx. 4m south of no.12 (grid ref: 348564,168738) in an southerly direction towards no.8 (grid ref: 348583,168716) Station Road approx. 30m in length, that will protrude into Embercourt Drive by approx. 6.5m.

The speed cushions measurements will be 1.8m long by 1.8m wide and no more than 75mm in height, subject to the permitted tolerances.

The raised tables will be full road width and approximately 75mm in height with approach ramps of 1 in 10, subject to the tolerances permitted in the regulations.
