Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by J Murphy & Sons on behalf of National Grid Company to construct bell mouths and lay ducts in carriageway (Contact: J Murphy & Sons (for National Grid) 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **27 February 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be in two phases. Phase One and Phase Two are each anticipated to be **30 days** in duration, the duration of Phase One is approximate and subject to the progression of the works. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Phase One Church Lane from approximately 45m north easterly direction of junction with Washing Pound Lane for approximately 85m. Phase Two Washing Pound Lane from the junction of Clevedon Road for approximately 100m.
