SUBJECT: Revision of the Tree Risk Management Plan

This revision updates the Tree Risk Management Plan (TRMP) which was first implemented in 2011 (Decision No. 10/11 DE 123) and describes how we carry out our duty of care in regards to the trees that we are responsible for.

Background:

Risk management needs to be as current as possible and it is standard practice to review processes in order to ensure that they are still fit for purpose.

This revised Tree Risk Management Plan (TRMP) explains how we manage the risks associated with the trees we own and also provides detailed guidance for Officers to implement the plan.
