Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 7 April 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Truespeed Communications Ltd to undertake laying ducts and clearing BT blockages for fibre optic equipment (Contact Truespeed 01225 300 370). This will become operative in three phases anticipated to commence on **7 April 2020** for Phase One, anticipated to commence on **21 April 2020** for Phase Two and anticipated to commence on **27 April 2020** for Phase Three. The timings for the phases are approximate and may be advanced or delayed subject to the progress of the previous phase of work. This is for a maximum period of 18 months, however, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **14 days** in duration for Phase One, anticipated to be **4 days** in duration for Phase Two and anticipated to be **2 days** in duration for Phase Three. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Phase One 7-20 April 2020 - Stanshalls Lane for its full extent from junction with West lane to junction with Currells Lane. Frog Lane from its junction with Stanshalls Lane for approximately 150m. Phase Two 21-24 April 2020 - Upper Town Lane for its full extent. Vee Lane from the junction with Upper Town Lane for approximately 133m. Phase Three 27-28 April - Currells Lane from the junction with Stanshalls Lane for approximately 260m. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to access overhead network for a new connection (Contact A Plant Lux for BT Openreach 0370 050 0792). This will become operative on **8 March 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration between approximately 9.30am to 3.30pm.
