Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Tower House Lane, Wraxall, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 22 January 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to gain safe access to BT Openreach network (contact BT Openreach - A Plant Lux 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **22 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **3 days** between approximately 8.30am to 4.30pm in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Truespeed Communications Ltd to install fibre optic equipment (Contact Truespeed 01225 300 370). This will become operative on **13 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **12 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Ham Lane for its full extent. **Alternative routes** – no suitable diversion for vehicles.

Temporary Waiting and Loading Order 2018
Date coming into force: 6 January 2020
Ref: T20-02

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order to prohibit any vehicle from waiting and loading at any time along the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon plan deliveries to the new construction site required by J Murphy & Sons Ltd on behalf of National Grid Hinckley works (contact: 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **6 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be 18 months in duration. Appropriate traffic and restriction signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Engine Lane from St Marys Grove to No. 16 Engine Lane. Blackfriars Road for its full extent with the restriction in phases. There will also be a footway closure. St Marys Grove from outside property number 70 for approximately 25m to junction of Engine Lane. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>
