Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to access overhead network for a new connection (Contact: A Plant Lux 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **8 March 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration between approximately 9.30am to 3.30pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - B3133 Kenn Road from its junction with Kenn Street past the Church to the junction with Kenn Road (also in conjunction with temporary traffic lights).
