Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order
Date coming into force: 17 February 2020
Ref: T20-14**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the schedule to this notice.

This order is required because of carriageway patching works and will become operative on **17 February 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration between 8am and 5pm.

Temporary 30mph Speed Limit Order 2020
Date coming into force: 30 January 2020
Ref: T20-24

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to suspend, temporarily the existing speed limit in favour restricting temporarily any vehicle to not exceeding 30mph in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

This order was required for safety purposes for the public and operatives consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to undertake gas main work (Contact WWU 08009 122 999). This will become operative on **30 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the speed restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of approximately **5 weeks** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Smallway - 30mph for its full extent - only where and when temporary speed restriction signs are displayed and in force. Frost Hill - 30mph for its full extent - only where and when temporary speed restriction signs are displayed and in force.
