This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by J Murphy & Sons on behalf of National Grid Company to construct bell mouths and lay ducts in carriageway (Contact: J Murphy & Sons 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **27 February 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be in two phases. Phase One and Phase Two are each anticipated to be **30 days** in duration, the duration of Phase One is approximate and subject to the progression of the works. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Notice; to temporarily restrict the speed of any vehicle from not exceeding 30mph in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; to temporarily revoke the Left Turn Only in the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.
