Fakeham Road, Bleadon, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 25 February 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to access overhead cabling for new connection (Contact BT Openreach - A Plant Lux 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **25 February 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration between approximately 9.30am and 3.30pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Fakeham Road from junction with Bridgwater Road outside Undercliff House for approximately 200m towards Coombe farm. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to install BT underground ducts (Contact: BT Openreach - Barden 01454 281 627). This will become operative on **20 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **10 days** in duration between approximately 9.30am and 3.30pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Temporary Waiting and Loading Restriction Order 2020
Date coming into force: 6 January 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to restrict, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by PG Enterprises for Schedule 1 (Contact: 01179 555 537) and LA Clark for schedule 2 development works (Contact: 01179 553 000 or 07950 398 207). This will become operative on **6 January 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **15 months** in duration for Schedule 1 and anticipated to be **12 days** in duration for Schedule 2. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force. Timings for Schedule 1 will be affective when signs are displayed and in force. Timings for Schedule 2 will be affective when traffic management signs are displayed and in force Mondays to Fridays between approximately 8am and 4pm.

Schedule 1 - Atlantic Road South from the entrance of property number 14 The White House for approximately 30m in a westerly direction on the south part of the road. **Schedule 2** - Highbury Road - from its junction with Atlantic Road South for approximately 60m in a southerly direction on both sides of the road.
