TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

Land at Lyefield Road, Worle, Weston-super-Mare (Direction No. 1)

WHEREAS the Woodspring District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") being the District Planning Authority for the District of Woodspring are satisfied that it is expedient that the development set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on those pieces of land adjoining Lyefield Road, Worle, Weston-super-Mare in the County of Avon shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order").

AND WHEREAS the Council are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the area, and that the provisions of Paragraph 3 (b) of Article 4 of the Order should apply to this Direction.

NOW THEREFORE the Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the said Article 4, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto within the said area.

This Direction is made in pursuance of the provisions of Paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until 23rd January 1981 (being six months from the date of this Direction and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date

SCHEDULE

Any development of the kind specified in Paragraph 2 of Class III of the First Schedule to the Order being:-

the formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to a highway not being a trunk or classified road, where required in connection with development permitted by Article 3 and Schedule I to the Order (other than under this Class)
