Article 4

Land adjoining the Trunk read A. 18 between Shute Shelve and East Frent

The Somerset County Council Act, 1960, contains a provision prohibiting the sale of food etc. from grass verges and because of this the local Planning Authority think it likely that stalls will be created on private land immediately adjoining the highway, perticularly along the length of the Trunk road A.38 between Shate Shelve and East Breat.

This is a very fast and busy section of the Trunk road and, in the circumstances, to assist them in controlling the use of land for the selling of food, provisions, etc. and the eraction of stalls in connection therewith the Local Planning Authority have made a Direction under Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, that development permitted by paragraph 2 of Class IV of the Pirst Schedule to the Order shall not be carried out on the strip of land on each side of the road and shown coloured pink on the plan accompanying the Direction.

The Direction is enclosed for the Minister's approval, together with a duplicate copy and also one fair copy.

# SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS, 1947 TO 1959 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950

WHEREAS the Somerset County Council being the Local Planning Authority for the administrative County of Somerset (hereinafter called "the Council") are satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the planning of the area including the interests of road safety that the development set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on land adjoining the Trunk road A.38 between Shute Shelve and East Brent shown coloured red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

#### SCHEDULE

Any development of the kind specified in paragraph 2 of Class IV of the First Schedule to the said Order, being - the use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) for the selling offering depositing or exposing for sale of any food goods provisions articles or things whatsoever on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use
