Gordano Valley (Direction No. 1/1)

WHEREAS the Woodspring District Council being the District Planning Authority for the District of Woodspring (hereinafter called "the Council") are satisfied that it is expedient that the development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land shown edged and hatched red on the plan annexed hereto and more particularly being land known generally as the Gordano Valley, within the Civil Parishes of Walton-in-Gordano, Weston-in-Gordano, North Weston, Clapton-in-Gordano and Portbury, and part within the boundary of the Town of Portishead, in the County of Avon, unless permission therefor is granted on an application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988, as amended by the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order 1989.

NOW THEREFORE the Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development of the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Development of the kind specified below:-

So much of the carrying out on agricultural land, comprised in an agricultural unit of -


(a) Works for the erection, extension or alteration of a building, or

(b) any excavation or engineering operations,

reasonably necessary for the purposes of agriculture within that unit, being development comprised within Class A of Part 6 of the Second Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 as amended by the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order 1989 and not being development comprised within any other Part or Class of that Schedule.
