Crockerne Primary School has an admission number of 45.  
 44 places were allocated in the first round of allocations on national offer day, 16<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

On 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018, 2 applications were considered for the 1 vacancy.  
 It has, therefore, been necessary to use the oversubscription criteria, as outlined below, to determine which of the applicants should be offered the places available.

The 1 available place has been offered to the following applicants:

Where a school is named in a child's Statement of Special Educational Needs Education or Health and Care Plan, the admission authority is legally required to admit the child to the school. Therefore such children are allocated places before the criteria, detailed below, are applied.

	The school is named in a Statement of Special Educational Needs or Education Health and Care Plan.	0 children
i	Children in Care at the time of application and children who were previously in Care but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order) immediately following having been in Care.	0 children
ii	Children with a brother or sister who was attending the school prior to September 2017 and either he/she or any younger brother or sister will be attending the school at the time of admission, where it is the nearest North Somerset school to the home address.	0 children
iii	Children with a brother or sister who started attending the school after or during September 2017 and he/she will be attending the school at the time of admission*, living within the First Geographical Area.	0 children
iv	Children living within the First Geographical Area.	1 child
v.	Children, living outside the First Geographical Area, with a brother or sister who will be attending the school at the time of admission.	0 children
vi.	Children living outside the First Geographical Area living nearest to the school.	0 children

The distance between home and school for the last child offered a place was 0.336 miles.

To admit another child to the school would cause prejudice to the provision of efficient education or the efficient use of resources by reason of 'relevant measures', i.e. measures

that would be required to be taken in order to ensure that the legal limit on class sizes of one teacher per 30 children is met at the school. Any appeals for places at the school are therefore 'infant class size prejudice cases'.
