Information about the school's admission arrangements is included in the book 'Starting School ~ a guide for parents'. It has not been possible to meet all the requests for places at and it has been necessary to use the oversubscription criteria, as described in the parent's guide and outlined below, to determine which of the applicants should be offered the places available.

Where a school is named in a child's Statement of Special Educational Needs or Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan the admission authority is legally required to admit the child to the school. Therefore such children are allocated places before the criteria are applied.

The 20 available places have been offered as follows:

The school is named in a Statement of Special Educational Needs or EHC plan ~ 0 children;

- i. Children in care at the time of application and children who were previously in care but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order) immediately following having been in care ~ 0 children;
- ii. Children with a brother or sister who was attending the school prior to September 2017 and either he/she or any younger brother or sister will be attending the school at the time of admission, where it is the nearest North Somerset school to the home address ~ 4 children:
- iii. Children with a brother or sister who started attending the school after or during September 2017 and he/she will be attending the school at the time of admission, living within the First Geographical Area ~ 0 children;
- iv. Children living within the First Geographical Area ~ 4 children;
- v. Children, living outside the First Geographical Area, with a brother or sister who will be attending the school at the time of admission ~ 4 children;
- vi. Children living outside the First Geographical Area living nearest to the school ~ 8 children.

The distance, measured in a direct line, between home and school for the last child offered a place was 3.759 miles.

To admit another child to the school would cause prejudice to the provision of efficient education or the efficient use of resources.
