Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Surf Telecoms to undertake installation of telecom ducts (Contact Taylor Plant for Surf Telecom 01934 853 311). This will become operative on **26 May 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **32 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Truespeed Communications Ltd to undertake laying ducts and clearing BT blockages for fibre optic equipment (Contact Truespeed Communications Ltd 01225 300 370). This will become operative in three phases anticipated to commence on **7 April 2020** for Phase One, anticipated to commence on **21 April 2020** for Phase Two and anticipated to commence on **27 April 2020** for Phase Three. The timings for the phases are approximate and may be advanced or delayed subject to the progress of the previous phase of work.
