Redundancy

Background:

A review of the structure of the Natural Environment team has been undertaken and there is a reduced requirement for the role of Asset Officer (Contracts). Therefore this role is being removed from the staffing establishment and resources have been refocused to better meet the needs of the service.

DECISION:

It is recommended to approve this potential redundancy (in the event that further redeployment opportunities are not identified).
