## SUBJECT: New Leases for the Cove Restaurant and Grotto Store, overlooking Marine Lake, off Birnbeck Road, WsM

### BACKGROUND:

The terms of the leases of the Cove Restaurant premises, which commenced 23 May 2006; and the lease of their nearby Grotto storage premises, which commenced 2 September 2009, have both expired and require renewal.

Terms have therefore now been agreed with the existing tenant for new 15 year leases of the restaurant premises, at a rental of £18,000 pa; and for the nearby storage premises, at a rental of £500 pa.

The rents currently passing under the previous, now expired, leases are £7,069 pa for the restaurant and £300 pa for the stores.

The proposed new leases would be on Full Repairing and Insuring terms, with 5 yearly rent reviews to a market rent, to be no lower than the rent passing at the review date. The tenant would be permitted to assign or sub-let, subject to Landlord's consent and each party would meet their own costs in completing the proposed new leases.

### **DECISION:**

To authorise officers to complete new leases of the Cove Restaurant and the Grotto storage premises on the terms as outlined above.

#### **REASONS:**

To regularise the terms of the tenant's occupation of the premises and to increase the Council's rental income for the premises.

### **OTHER ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:**

None

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Under the new leases, the Council's income from these premises will be increased by approximately £11.100 pa

#### **IMPLICATIONS FOR FUTURE YEARS:**

Over the full 15 year term of the new leases, the Council will receive a minimum of  $\pounds 277,500$  rental income, plus any increase which may be agreed at the 5 yearly rent review dates during the term of the new leases.
