SUBJECT: Proposed Lease of Wood Lane Quarry

BACKGROUND:

Heads of Terms have been agreed to grant a 25 year lease of the Wood Lane Quarry, as shown shaded pink on the attached plan, at a peppercorn rent, to Play Wild! Ltd, for the purposes of providing forest school type activities.

These Heads of Terms are to be offered subject to contract and subject to the tenant providing evidence of having secured sufficient funding to make the quarry face sufficiently safe for the proposed use.

This Heads of Terms agreement is required in order for the tenant to be able to demonstrate to the funding source that a subject to contract agreement for a lease of the premises has been reached subject to their securing sufficient funding.

DECISION:

To authorise officers to grant a 25 year lease of Wood Lane Quarry to Play Wild! Ltd at a peppercorn rent subject to the tenant securing the required funding to make the premises safe before commencement of their proposed use as a forest school.

REASONS:

To make beneficial use of an amenity which is currently considered to be under-utilised and for which the Council does not currently have funds available to make the premises sufficiently safe to put them to use.
