**Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020**  
**Various Roads, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset**  
**Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting & Loading) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Movements) Order 2020**  
**Ref: NSC/T20/21**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and the Road Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to restrict traffic in the lengths of roads in Weston-super-Mare listed in Schedule 1 of this order. North Somerset Council is satisfied that traffic in lengths of said roads listed in Schedule 1 of this order should be restricted because of works to construct the Weston-super-Mare Transport Enhancement Scheme are being or are proposed to be executed on or near said roads.

In this order 'civil enforcement officer' has the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, 'police community support officer' has the same definition as in section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002 and 'traffic warden' means a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of sections 95 and 96 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any powers or functions given to a traffic warden in this order may also be exercised by a police officer in uniform.

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, a traffic warden, a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of roads or on any of the sides of roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 to this order, to make a right turn into the road specified in relation to that road in column 2 of said Schedule.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 4 to this order, to make a left turn into the road specified in relation to that road in column 2 of said Schedule.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 6 in the direction of the temporary prohibition restriction as this order details in column 2 of said Schedule within the restriction extents also detailed in said Schedule.
5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 5 to this order.
6. Nothing in Article 5 of this order shall apply to any vehicle necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
7. The provisions of Article 1 and Article 2 and Article 3 and Article 4 and Article 5 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs specified or authorised pursuant to Section 64 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
8. All permanent orders are hereby suspended insofar as they relate to Schedule 2, Schedule 3, Schedule 4, Schedule 5 and Schedule 6 of this for the duration of the works and as necessitated by the works.
9. This order will become operative on **2 April 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the traffic restrictions as described in this order may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works, which is anticipated to be **11 months** in duration.

Oxford Street from a point adjacent to number 39 Oxford Street to its junction with Walliscote Road. Regent Street for the entire length of the road. Richmond Street from its junction with Gloucester Street to its junction with St. James Street. St James Street from its junction with Richmond Street to its junction with Regent Street. Union Place for the entire length of the road. Walliscote Road from its junction with Locking Road to its junction with Oxford Street. Meadow Street from its junction with North Street to its junction with Alexandra Parade.

Alma Street

(a) from a point adjacent to number 4 Alma Street to its junction with Alexandra Parade –

(b) from its junction with Alexandra Parade to a point adjacent to number 4 Alma Street –

Alternative route - Alexandra Parade, Alfred Street, Meadow Street.

Beaconsfield Road

(a) from its junction with Walliscote Road to a point adjacent to number 3

Beaconsfield Road –

Alternative route – Graham Road, Neva Road, Walliscote Road.

(b) from a point adjacent to number 3 Beaconsfield Road to its junction with Walliscote Road –

Alternative route – Walliscote Road, Neva Road, Graham Road.

Francis Fox Road

(a) for the entirety of the length of the northbound lane – Alternative route – Station Road (A370), Walliscote Road, Regent Street, Alexandra Parade, Locking Road.

Graham Road

(a) from its junction with Station Road (A370) to its junction with Beaconsfield Road –  
Alternative route – Station Approach, Station Road, Neva Road.

(b) from its junction with Beaconsfield Road to its junction with Station Road (A370) –

Alternative route – Neva Road, Station Road, Station Approach.

Locking Road

(a) from its westernmost extent to its junction with Alexandra Parade –

Alternative route – Locking Road, Francis Fox Road, Station Road, Walliscote Road, Regent Street.

(b) from a point adjacent to number 11 Locking Road to its westernmost extent –

Alternative route – Regent Street, Alexandra Parade.

Orchard Place

(a) for the entire length of the road –

Alternative route – Meadow Street, Alexandra Parade.

Orchard Street

(a) from a point adjacent to number 2 Orchard Place to its junction with Alexandra Parade –

Alternative route – Meadow Street, Alexandra Parade.

(b) from its junction with Alexandra Parade to a point adjacent to number 2 Orchard Place –

Oxford Street

Regent Street

(a) for the entire length of the road –

Alternative route – Locking Road, Alfred Street, Boulevard, Waterloo Street, South Parade, Knightstone Road, Royal Parade.

Station Road (A370)

(a) from its westernmost extent to its junction with Hildesheim Bridge –

Alternative route – Walliscote Grove Road, Carlton Street, Beach Road, Marine Parade, Royal Parade, Knightstone Road, South Parade, Waterloo Street, Boulevard, Alfred Street, Locking Road, Francis Fox Road.

(b) from its junction with Hildesheim Bridge to its westernmost extent –

Alternative route – Francis Fox Road, Locking Road, Alfred Street, Boulevard, Waterloo Street, South Parade, Knightstone Road, Royal Parade, Marine Parade, Carlton Street, Walliscote Grove Road.

(a) from its northernmost extent to its junction with Wilton Gardens –

Alternative route – Regent Street, Alexandra Parade, Locking Road, Francis Fox Road, Station Approach, Station Road, Neva Road.

(b) from its junction with Wilton Gardens to its northernmost extent –  
Alternative route – Neva Road, Station Road, Station Approach, Francis Fox Road,  
Locking Road, Regent Street.

**Schedule 6** – Temporary prohibition of vehicle movements:

Station Road (A370) – vehicle movements will be restricted in an eastbound direction as necessitated by the works, from its westernmost extent to its roundabout junction with Francis Fox Road, Hildesheim Bridge and Station Approach.

Walliscote Road – vehicle movements will be restricted in a southbound direction as necessitated by the works, from its northernmost extent to its junction with Beaconsfield Road.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the schedule to this notice.

**This order** is required because of culvert installation works and kerbing works, and will become operative on **23 March 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months.
