Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Whitehouse Lane, Wraxall, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 14 April 2020
Ref: T20-27

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by National Grid Company to construct a Bell-mouth access (Contact J Murphy & Sons for National Grid 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **14 April 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **18 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Whitehouse Lane from junction with Cuckoo Lane for approximately 125m to junction with Caswell Hill. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>
