On 24 February 2020, in accordance with The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 and the 'Making significant changes ('prescribed alterations') to maintained schools – Statutory guidance for proposers and decision makers, October 2018', Westhaven Special School published a statutory proposal to make a prescribed alteration from 01 September 2020. The above Order made on 20 February 2020, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading Footpath AX 29/76 onto the Definitive Map for the area as Restricted Byway AX 29/76. Footpath AX 29/76 Point A (Grid Ref: ST42043 59885) commences from its junction with the adopted highway known as Nye Road and proceeds in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 311m until it reaches the junction of adopted highway known as Sandmead Road, Point E (Grid Ref: ST42345 59941). This route will be known as Restricted Byway AX 29/76.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
