**Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020**  
**B3130 Barrow Street, Barrow Gurney, North Somerset**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020**  
**Date coming into force: 10 May 2020**  
**Ref: T20-442**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to de-silting and connection of a new supply (Contact A Plant Lux for BT Openreach 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **10 May 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration between approximately 8am and 4pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which has closed, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** was required because of works on the carriageway and will become operative on **9 March 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days**, between 8am and 5pm.

Notice is hereby given that on 6 March 2020 North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as 'the council') made the following order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The general effect of the Order shall be to impose parking restrictions on Weston Road and Lovelinch Gardens, described in the Schedule to this Notice.

There will be 4 restrictions types on the described roads.

- Double yellow lines which will prevent waiting at all times.
- Single yellow lines which prevent waiting and loading between Monday and Friday between the hours of 8am and 9am and 3pm and 4pm.
- Single yellow lines which prevent waiting between Monday and Friday between the hours of 8am and 9am and 3pm and 4pm.
- Single yellow lines which prevent waiting between Monday and Saturday between the hours of 9am and 6pm.
- Marked parking bays which restrict parking between Monday and Saturday between the hours of 9am and 6pm to a maximum stay of two hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**20mph and 50mph Speed Limit**

Notice is hereby given that on 6 March 2020 North Somerset Council made the following order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be:

- To restrict any vehicle exceeding **20mph** on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- To restrict any vehicle exceeding **50mph** on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

**The order** will come into operation on **9 March 2020** and copies of this together with plans and a copy of the council's statement of reasons for making the order may be inspected at [www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices](http://www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices). **Schedule 1 (20mph Speed Limit)** - Weston Road from a point 24m west of the junction with Providence Lane to a point 42m south west of the junction with Lovelinch Gardens. **Schedule 2 (50mph Speed Limit)** - Weston Road from a point 75m south west of the junction with Wildcountry Lane to a point 190m east of the junction with B3130 Clevedon Road.
