Pudding Pie Lane, Langford, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 27 April 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water for a new water connection (Contact Bristol Water 01179 662 267). This will become operative on **27 April 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **4 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice of Correction to Statutory Proposal

On 27 February notice was given of the proposed change of age range at Westhaven Special School. The corrected notice is as below.

Proposed change of age range at Westhaven Special School on 24 February 2020, in accordance with The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 and the 'Making significant changes ('prescribed alterations') to maintained schools – Statutory guidance for proposers and decision makers, October 2018', Westhaven Special School published a statutory proposal to make a prescribed alteration from 1 September 2020. The Governing Body of the school are proposing to introduce the provision of sixth form education on the school site by making a change to the age range from a 138-place age 4 to 16 years Special School to a 148-place age 4 to 19 years Special School with effect from 1 September 2020. The proposal will be implemented by the Governing Body with support from North Somerset Council.
