

# DECISION OF DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENT

DECISION NO. 15/16 – 16/17 DE 271

SUBJECT: Authorisation of Veterinary Inspector under the Riding Establishments Acts 1964 and 1970.

### Background:

It is a legal requirement under the Riding Establishments Acts 1964 and 1970 that the Authority employs a veterinary inspector to inspect these premises for animal welfare purposes. The veterinary inspector must be a member of the RCVS/BVA Inspectorate of approved Riding Establishment Inspectors.

### **DECISION:**

That the local Authority authorises Mr Scott Milnes - BVSc Cert EP MRCVS of B & W Equine Group to carry out veterinary inspections at riding establishments on the Authority's behalf.

#### Reasons:

Failure to appoint an appropriately qualified vet to carry out this work will result in the Authority being in breach of its statutory duties.

# **Other Alternatives Considered:**

There are no alternatives to this proposal.

# Risk Assessment:

There are no substantial risks associated with this contract.

#### Financial Implications:
