

**North Somerset Council  
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14  
Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order  
High Street, Nailsea, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles 2020  
Date coming into force: 12 June 2020**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to:

- 1) close, temporarily, to vehicles, the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
- 2) ban all right turn vehicle movements at the junction of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

**Exemptions** are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the need to implement social distancing measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order will become operative on the 12th June 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Alternative routes** - Station Road, Brockway, Stockway North, Link Road.

**Schedule 1** - High Street, Nailsea from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Link Road.  
**Schedule 2** - The Courtyard, Nailsea at its junction with Link Road.
