**Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020**

**Whitehouse Lane, Caswell Lane and Caswell Hill, Portbury, North Somerset**

**Speed Limits Order 2020**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council proposes to make an Order under sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be (1) to restrict any vehicle exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in the schedule 1 to this Notice (2) to restrict any vehicle exceeding 40mph on the lengths of road specified in the schedule 2 to this Notice.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a plan and a statement of the councils reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Highways and Transport Department, North Somerset Council, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon BS21 6FW (callers should report to reception and ask for the Highways Section Design Team B during normal office hours). Should you wish to make any observations on this proposal (whether you support or object) you should make them in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, North Somerset Council, Town Hall, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1UJ quoting reference **CTR-AEB-WL/CL** by **5pm on 16 July 2020**. Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the council and that the substance of any representation, together with the name and address of the person making it, could become available for public inspection.

**Schedule 1 (30mph Speed Limit)** - Whitehouse Lane from a point approximately 160m south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 155m. **Schedule 2 (40mh Speed Limit)** – Whitehouse Lane from a point approximately 70m south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 90. Whitehouse Lane from a point approximately 315m south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 70m. Caswell Lane from a point approximately 220m east of its junction with Caswell Hill to a point 120m west of the junction. Caswell Hill from its junction with Caswell Lane in a southerly direction for approximately 120m.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by National Grid Company to lay new service ducts under M5 (Contact J Murphys for National Grid 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **27 July 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be approximately **40 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to undertake tree removal. This will become operative on **13 July 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
