Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Baker Street, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles and Temporary Suspension of
Traffic Order 2020
Date coming into force: 27 July 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. 1. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this notice. 2. To suspend, temporarily, the one-way traffic order specified in Schedule 2 of this notice.

This order is required because of carriageway and footway resurfacing works and will become operative on **27 July 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **10 days** in duration between 8am and 4pm.

Schedule 1 - Baker Street from the junction with Gerard Road for its full length to the junction of Alfred Street. **Schedule 2** – George Street full length from Baker Street through to Locking Road. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Listed Building Application in a Conservation Area

20/P/0582/LBC - Demolish an internal non load bearing ground floor wall between a bedroom and reception room to create new kitchen. Remove existing window in reception room and replace with reclaimed Victorian French patio doors to create access to garden. Remove existing internal door to reception and widen doorway, using RSJ to support wider opening from hall to new kitchen and fit reclaimed Victorian French doors at Ground Floor, 2 Ellenborough Crescent, Weston-super-Mare.

20/P/0646/LBC - Replacement of existing single glazed wooden windows with double glazed wooden windows to north, east, south and west elevations. Insertion of internal secondary glazing to 2x original windows on north elevation at Manor Farm, Ebdon Lane, Wick-St-Lawrence.
