

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14**  
**Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020**  
**Chapel Lane, High Street, Claverham, North Somerset**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020**  
**Date coming into force: 8 June 2020**  
**Ref: T20-38**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to undertake ducting and installation for fibre optic cable (contact Obelisk for Gigaclear 07795 834 193). This will become operative on **8 June 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases for Chapel Lane and two phases for High Street. Phase One for Chapel Lane and High Street is anticipated to commence **8 June 2020** and both anticipated to be **14 days** in duration, Chapel Lane Phase Two anticipated to commence **3 August 2020** and anticipated to be **14 days** in duration; High Street Phase Two anticipated to commence **17 August** and anticipated to be **13 days** in duration. The timings of the commencement of the second phases are approximate and may be advanced or delayed subject to the progression of the works. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Chapel Lane for its full extent in 2 phases. High Street from junction of Jasmine Lane to Chapel Lane in 2 phases. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>
