Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Winthill, The Rhodyate, Dark Lane, Banwell, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 15 June 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Surf Telecoms and their contractors Taylor Plant on behalf of Western Power Distribution to lay communication ducting (contact Taylor Plant for Surf Telecoms/WPD 01934 853 311). This will become operative on **15 June 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be in three phases and anticipated to be **2 days** in duration for Phase One commencing **15 June 2020** and anticipated to be **2 days** in duration for Phase 2 anticipated to commence **17 June 2020** and anticipated to be **6 days** in duration for Phase 3 anticipated to commence **18 June 2020**. The timings of the Phases are approximate and may be advanced or delayed subject to the progression of the works of the previous Phase. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Phase 1 Winthill from the track next to the Roman Building to the junction with The Rhodyate. Phase 2 The Rhodyate from junction of Winthill to the junction of Castle Hill. Phase 3 Dark Lane from junction of Castle Hill to the field off Dark Lane.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to install a water main. This will become operative on **20 July 2020** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in three phases, which is anticipated to be **43 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Bleadon Hill from West to East in three phases from outside property number 47 to Hillcote. Phase One from Totterdown Lane to Leighton Crescent. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provision of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, has made an Order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily to vehicles, the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

This order is required for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road arising from works to widen and resurface the road. This Order became operative on **2 December 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the authorisation may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated in this instance to be **Wednesday 10 June 2020** and **Thursday 11 June 2020** (between 8pm and 6am). When a closure is active, road closed signs will be displayed and a diversion system will operate.
