

NOTICE OF MAKING

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

AMENDMENTS TO GENERAL TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IN WESTON-SUPER-MARE

1. Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that on the 14th June 2017 North Somerset District Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) have made Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders insofar as they relate to Alfred Street, Alexandra Parade and Locking Road shall be to:
 - (a) revoke the existing one-way traffic restriction between Alfred Street junction and Locking Road to reflect the proposed two-way road alignment.
 - (b) revoke the bus lane to allow use by all types of vehicles.
 - (c) revoke the pay and display on street parking outside the Red Admiral pub.
 - (d) revoke the existing yellow box junction
 - (e) extend the existing no loading/unloading 9am-6pm double yellow approx. 20m in a southerly direction and no waiting double yellow lines approx. 3m in a northerly direction outside the Red Admiral pub.
 - (f) provide two taxi only bays on Locking Road. One near to Tesco’s approx. 42m in length and one opposite Jubilee Road approx. 30m in length.
 - (g) introduce a no entry traffic restriction from the proposed two-way road alignment into Alexandra Parade, northern section.
 - (h) introduce a no U-turn traffic restriction on Locking Road at the end of the central island.
3. These Orders will be operational from the 19th June 2017 and copies thereof together with maps and a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the order may be inspected at the Highways and Transportation Department, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon, BS21 6FW (callers should report to Reception and ask for the above order) during normal office hours.
4. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
