

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14  
Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order  
Bransby Way, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use By Vehicles Order  
Date came into force: 23 March 2020  
Ref: T20-18**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the schedule to this notice.

**This order** is required because of culvert installation works and kerbing works and became operative on **23 March 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **26 days** in duration from **12 August 2020**. The culvert will be constructed by the Zebra Crossing between 60 and 62 Bransby Way. While this work is being undertaken, we will take advantage of the closure, and undertake planned kerbing work around the junction of Shrewsbury Bow / Bransby Way. Therefore, we will be extending the closure to include this junction. Access will be granted through the Shrewsbury Bow works but may experience a wait of up to 15 minutes.

**Schedule** - Bransby Way (47830470) and Shrewsbury Bow (47830800) between 60 Bransby Way and 2 Shrewsbury Bow. **Alternative routes** – Somerset Avenue through Locking Castle housing estate and vice versa.
