NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

(VARIOUS ROADS, WESTON-SUPER-MARE, NORTH SOMERSET) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING & LOADING) ORDER 2020

Date Coming Into Force: 10th August 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and of all other enabling powers, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to:

- Convert an existing P&D parking space at the north-eastern end of Richmond Street to a disabled parking space.
- Remove the existing disabled parking spaces on Regent Street (between St James Street and Princess Royal Square) and replace with a no waiting/loading at any time restriction.
- Remove the existing disabled parking spaces on St James Street (between Regent Street and Richmond Street) and replace with a no waiting/loading at any time restriction.
- Reduce the length of the loading/bus bay outside Grand Pier to facilitate a new bus stop.
- Create a new short-stay (2hr max stay) parking place on Ellenborough Park Road adjacent to Cowan House and No.11 Ellenborough Park Road.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and enforcement of the restrictions.

This order is required because of the need to implement measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order will become operative on the 10th August 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when and where the measures are in force.
