

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL

(QUEEN'S WAY, WORLE, WESTON-SUPER-MARE, NORTH SOMERSET)
(RESTRICTED ROAD) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81(1), 82(1) and (2), and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1) The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act of 1984, where no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
- 2) Queen's Way, Worle, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset (Restricted Road) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1998 by virtue of which a speed limit of 40 miles per hour was imposed on the length of road specified in Schedule 3, Item 4 to this Order, is hereby revoked.
- 3) This Order shall come into operation on xxxxx 2017 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Queen's Way, Worle, Weston-super-mare, North Somerset (Restricted Road) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017.

That length of Queen's Way which extends from a point 102 metres west of its junction with the Wansbrough Road roundabout in an easterly direction until its junction with B3440 Bristol Road, a distance of approximately 607 metres.
