

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, BLEADON, NORTH SOMERSET) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES OVER 7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT) ORDER 20**

The District Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the Xth XXXXXX 2017 and may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Various Roads, Bleadon, North Somerset) (Prohibition of Vehicles Over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) Order 20--.

2. In this order :-

“goods” includes money and postal packets of any description;

“local bus” has the meaning assigned to it by Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“maximum gross weight” has the meaning assigned to it by Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“money” includes a cheque, banknote, postal order or money order;

“school bus” has the meaning assigned to it by Section 1 (2) of the School Bus (Safety) Bill 2008-2009;

3. Save as provided in Article 4 and Article 5 of this order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to enter or proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall render it unlawful for any vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, to proceed in any length of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to or with access from the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;

(c) in connection with carrying out on or on premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order any of the following operations;

- i. building, industrial or demolition operation;
- ii. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- iii. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road or the sides of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- iv. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

(d) to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and at which the vehicle is to be or has been garaged, serviced, or repaired;

(e) in the service of a Local Authority, Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;

(f) for the purpose of collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125(1) of the Postal Services Act 2000;

(g) any security company armoured vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting money;

(h) for fire brigade, ambulance or police in the execution of their duties;

5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to:

(a) a local bus;

(b) a school bus.

6. This Order will revoke the North Somerset District Council (Various Roads, Bleadon, North Somerset) (Prohibition of Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) (Prohibition of Buses) Order 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight

- Bleadon Road** - whole length.
- Bridge Road** - from its junction with Bleadon Road southward to the access to Marshalls Quarry, a distance of 155 metres.
- Celtic Way** - whole length.
- Coronation Road** - whole length.
- Shiplate Road** - from Celtic Way to a point 200 metres east of The Veale.
- Whitehouse Lane** - from a point 250 metres south of Shiplate Road for a distance of 100 metres.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that North Somerset Council proposes to make an order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1984), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, the effect of which will be to;

1. prohibit vehicles of over 7.5 tonnes to access the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

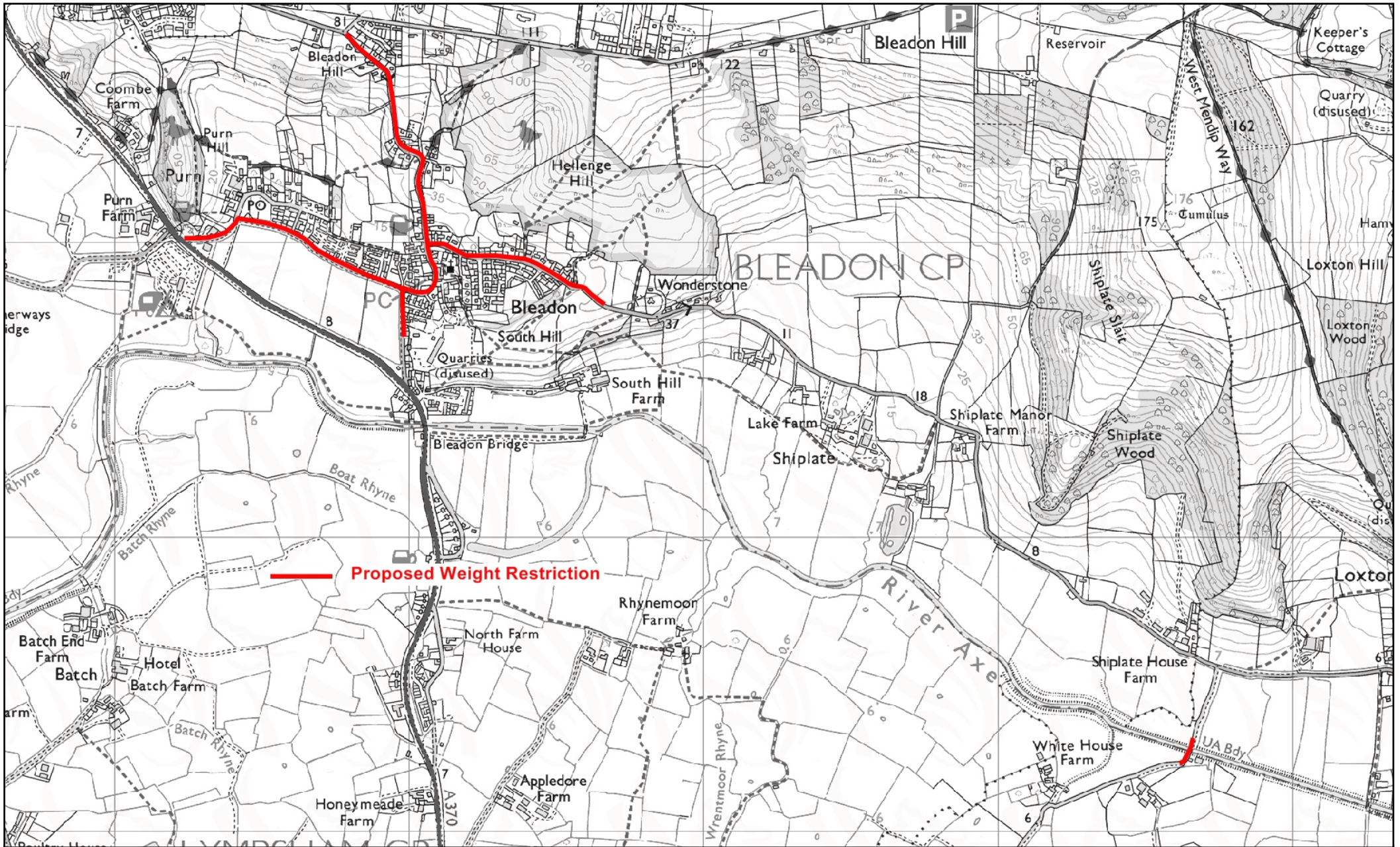

Prohibition of Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight and Buses

- Bleadon Road** - whole length.
- Bridge Road** - from its junction with Bleadon Road southward to the access to Marshalls Quarry, a distance of 155 metres.
- Celtic Way** - whole length.
- Coronation Road** - whole length.
- Shiplate Road** - from Celtic Way to a point 200 metres east of The Veale.
- Whitehouse Lane** - from a point 250 metres south of Shiplate Road for a distance of 100 metres.

Statement of Reasons

This Order prevents the travel of vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight. This is intended to prevent the movement of these vehicles on smaller unsuitable roads. This will prevent damage to the highway and surrounding environment.

This Order will:-

- Avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the roads, and will prevent the likelihood of any danger arising;
- Prevent damage to the roads or any building located on or near the specified roads;
- Facilitate the passage on the roads, or any other roads, of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- Prevent the use of the roads by vehicular traffic which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property;
- Preserve the character of the roads in a case where it is specially suitable for use by persons on horseback or on foot;
- Preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
