Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to restrict any vehicle exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice. To restrict any vehicle exceeding 40mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice. Due to Covid-19 full details of the proposals are unavailable to view at council buildings, the full details are contained in the Draft Order, a Plan and a Statement of the councils Reasons for proposing to make the Order, and these documents can alternatively be viewed online at www.n-somerset.gov.uk

Should you wish to make any observations on this proposal (whether you support or object to the proposal) you should make them in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, North Somerset Council, Town Hall, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1UJ quoting reference **B3133 NORTH END YATTON** by **5pm** on **7 August 2020**. Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

**Notice of Confirmation of an Order
Highways Act 1980
North Somerset District Council
(Parts of footpaths LA 2/33 and LA 2/34,
over land crossing Grove Farm, Chelvey Road, Backwell)
Public Path Diversion Order No. 3 2019**

On 25 June 2020 North Somerset Council confirmed the above Order, made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert those parts of Public Footpaths LA 2/33 and LA 2/34 in the Parish of Backwell within the District of North Somerset as described below: Public Footpath LA 2/33 from grid ref. ST 47124 68698 near a footbridge, running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 927m through Grove Farm, to ST 47771 68087; to a footpath from ST 47124 68698, initially running in a generally south easterly direction, then taking footpath users away from the Grove Farm buildings, to run in a generally southerly then generally easterly direction to ST 47771 68087; a total distance of approximately 1090m; Public Footpath LA 2/34 from grid ref. ST 47454 68054 running in a generally north, north easterly direction through Grove Farm for approximately 560m, to ST 47730 68539; to a footpath from ST 47424 68334 taking footpath users away from the Grove Farm buildings and running in a generally north easterly direction to ST 47424 68334; a total distance of approximately 372m. The Order comes into force on 23 July 2020 but, if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question it's validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 15 July 2020, make an application to the High Court. For information (and not part of this Order) – a separate Creation Agreement has created two new Public Footpath links, one going west and the other north then west, to join with the existing route of LA 2/33. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by National Grid Company to construct a Bell-mouth access (contact J Murphy & Sons for National Grid 07774 167 466). This will become operative on **4 August 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **14 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to undertake a pole replacement, tree trimming and new connection (contact - A Plant Lux for BT 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **28 July 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration between 9.30am and 3.30pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
