**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Brandwells for Newland Homes to install new sewer for development works. This will become operative on **23 July 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **45 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by North Somerset District Council to install ducting for WPD Hinckley works in conjunction with works on A368. This will become operative on **24 August 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to repair cover and frame. #### **Public Path Diversion Order No. 2 2020**

On 9 July 2020 North Somerset Council confirmed the above Orders, made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Orders as confirmed is to divert those parts of Public Footpaths AX 14/32 and AX 14/46 in the Parish of Churchill within the District of North Somerset. AX 14/32 (ref. PAP/PPO184a): from grid ref. ST 45050 60877, at Ladymead Lane, running in a generally westerly, then generally south, south westerly direction for approximately 482m, to ST 44675 60747; to a footpath from a kissing gate at ST 45032 60830 at Ladymead Lane, running over a culvert bridge in a generally westerly direction for approximately 129m to a pedestrian gate at ST 44905 60840, then a west, south westerly direction for approximately 134m to ST 44779 60796. The route then runs in a west, south westerly direction for approximately 31m to a pedestrian gate at ST 44751 60781, then in a west, south westerly direction for approximately 84m to a pedestrian gate at ST 44675 60747. AX 14/46 (ref. PAP/PPO184b): from grid ref. ST 45071 61051 running in a southerly then south, south westerly direction for approximately 185m to ST 45054 60871; to a footpath from ST 45071 61051 running in a south, south westerly direction for approximately 18m to a field gate at ST 45064 61034 then in a southerly then south, south westerly direction for approximately 151m to a kissing gate at ST 45056 60886.

The Orders come into force on 6 August 2020 but, if any person aggrieved by the Orders desires to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that they are not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 16 July 2020, make an application to the High Court.
