**SUBJECT:** School Admission Arrangements, Coordinated Admission Schemes and Admission Numbers for 2018-19.

**DECISION:** That the following policies, schemes and Admission Numbers are accepted and adopted by the Authority.

**BACKGROUND:**

1. The School Admissions (Admission Arrangements and Co-ordination of Admission Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2012 requires all admission authorities to consult on their proposed arrangements before determining final admission arrangements. The regulations establish key dates by which every admission authority should have completed its consultations and determined its arrangements. These are 31<sup>st</sup> January and 28<sup>th</sup> February.
2. Details of the proposed admission arrangements for North Somerset Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools and Coordinated Admission Scheme for 2016-17 school year have been circulated to the following groups for comments:

The Diocese of Bath and Wells, the Clifton Diocese and the Methodist Church  
Town and Parish Councils in North Somerset

Local Members of Parliament  
North Somerset Strategic Schools Forum  
North Somerset People and Communities Directorate Leadership Team and other officers

The consultation was open to the public on the North Somerset website.

3. Responses to the proposals in the consultation were received and are available for inspection. They are summarised as follows:

- Deputy Headteacher at St Katherine's School was in support of the proposed Fair Access Protocol.
4. The document Admission Numbers details any changes to the admission number for the 2018 intake; the only one is as below.

~~Flax Bourton C of E Primary School are increasing the school from a PAN of 15 to 30 for 2018-19.~~

Winford C of E Primary School are increasing from a PAN of 20 to 30 for 2018-19.
