Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this notice. To suspend, temporarily, the one-way traffic order specified in Schedule 2 of this notice.

This order is required because of carriageway resurfacing works and will become operative on **19 August 2020** anticipated to be **3 days** in duration between 8am and 4pm.

Schedule 1 – Baker Street from the junction with Gerard Road for its full length to the junction of Alfred Street. **Schedule 2** – George Street full length from Baker Street through to Locking Road. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to install ducting in footway (contact Sunbelt Rentals for BT 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **6 August 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to replace a lead pipe (contact Bristol Water 01179 662 267). This will become operative on **17 August 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **4 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
