

Starting school - September 2020 Allocation Sheet for Corpus Christi Catholic Primary School

National Offer Day (16 April 2020)

Corpus Christi Catholic Primary School has a Published Admission Number of 30.

59 preferences have been received for the school. It has, therefore been necessary to use the oversubscription criteria, as outlined below, to determine which of the applicants should be offered the places available.

The 30 available places have been offered to the following applicants:

Where a school is named in a child's Statement of Special Educational Needs or Education Health and Care Plan, the admission authority is legally required to admit the child to the school. Therefore such children are allocated places before the admissions criteria, detailed below, are applied.

4	Baptised Catholic children who live outside the Parishes named above and who will have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission.	0

6	Children in Care at the time of application and children who were previously in Care but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order) immediately following having been in Care who are not Baptised Catholic.	0

Priority within each category is determined by random allocation (drawing lots).

To admit another child to the school would cause prejudice to the provision of efficient education or the efficient use of resources by reason of 'relevant measures', i.e. measures that would be required to be taken in order to ensure that the legal limit on class sizes of one teacher per 30 children is met at the school. Any appeals for places at the school are therefore 'infant class size prejudice cases'.
