This order is required because of carriageway and footway resurfacing works and will become operative on **24 August 2020** anticipated to be **5 days** in duration between 8am and 4pm.

Notice is hereby given that The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of its powers under sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be: (1) To restrict any vehicle exceeding **20mph** on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 and 2 to this notice. (2) To restrict any vehicle exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 and 4 to this notice. Due to Covid 19 full details of the proposals are unavailable to view at council buildings, the full details are contained in the Draft Order, Plans and a Statement of the Councils Reasons for proposing to make the Order, and these documents can alternatively be viewed at www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices. Should you wish to make any observations on this proposal (whether you support or object to the proposal) you should make them in writing to the postal address or the email address below quoting reference **BWSL/SLO/DB** by **5pm** on **28 August 2020**. Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. All representations received may be considered in public by the council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

Schedule 1 (proposed 20mph speed limit) Backwell Village - Station Road from a point 60m north west of its junction with Moor Lane to a point 50m north west of its junction with West Town Road (a distance of approximately 885m in a south easterly direction). Backwell Common from its junction with Station Road in a generally north east direction for approximately 70m. Backwell Hill from its junction with Church Town in a generally south east direction for approximately 80m. Backwell Hill Road from its junction with the A370 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 85m. Chapel Hill from its junction with the A370 in a northerly direction for approximately 90m.

The speed limit shall apply to the entire lengths of the following roads: Alison Gardens, Amberlands Close, Backwell Hill Road (Unclassified section), Bramley Drive, Church Lane, Church Town, Combe Side, rear access to Combe Side and Chelsfield, Court Close, Dark Lane, Embercourt Drive, Fairfield Way, Fairfield Mead, Fairfield Way, Fernside, Garstons Close, Hilldale Road, Hillside Road, Karen Close, Karen Drive, rear access to Ladymeade and Chelsfield, Lawnside, Longthorn, Luntly Mead, Mariners Close, Mariners Drive, Marle Pits, Meadow Close, Moorfield Road, Moor Lane, Mulberry Close, Oakleigh Close, Orchard Road, Robinson Close, Robinson Way, Rodney Road, Rushmoor Grove, Rushmoor Lane, Russett Close,

Slades Court, St Andrews Road, St John's Road, St Margarets Close, St Margarets Lane, Summerlands, The Briars, The Crescent, The Croft, Uncombe Close, Waverley Road, Westfield Close, Westfield Drive, Westfield Road.

Schedule 2 (proposed 20mph speed limit) Wrington Village - High Street from a point 43m south east of its junction with Chapel Hill to its junction with Broad Street a distance of 310m. Butts Batch from its junction with Station Road south for 80m. Silver Street from a point 86m north of its junction with Garstons to its junction with Broad Street. Ropers Lane from its junction with Chapel Hill to its junction with Wrington Hill a distance of 500m.

The speed limit shall apply to the entire lengths of the following roads: Broad Street, Brooklyn, Garstons, Garstons Close, Garstons Orchard, Hannah More Close, Home Close, Kings Road, Ladywell, Lawrence Road, Old Station Close, Orchard Close, Rickyard Road, School Road, South Meadows, Station Road, The Glebe, The Triangle, Westward Close, Wiltons, Church Walk, Yeomans Orchard.

Schedule 3 (proposed restricted roads) Backwell Village - Backwell Hill from a point approximately 80m from its junction with Church Town in a generally south east direction for approximately 100m. Backwell Common from a point 70m north east of its junction with Station Road to a point 80m north east of its junction with The Avenue (a distance of approximately 207m in a north easterly direction). Backwell Hill Road from a point approximately 85m south of its junction with the A370 in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 295m. Chapel Hill from a point approximately 90m north of its junction with the A370 in a generally northerly direction for 510m.

Schedule 4 (proposed restricted roads) Wrington Village - Silver Street from its junction with Cox's Green north for approximately 86m. Cox's Green from its junction with Silver street in a southerly direction to its junction with Havyatt Road a distance of approximately 170m. Cox's Green from its junction with Havyatt Road in a generally south east direction to a point 51m north of its junction with Mill Lane a distance of approximately 293m. Havyatt Road from its junction with Cox's Green in a generally southern direction for approximately 291m. Butts Batch from a point 80m south of it junction with Station Road in a generally southern direction to its junction with Half Yard a distance of approximately 351m. Half Yard from its junction with Butts Batch in a generally southern direction for approximately 62m. High Street from its junction with Chapel Hill south east for 43m. West Hay Road from its junction with Chapel Hill in a generally westerly direction for 370m. Alburys its entire length. Chapel Hill its entire length. Ropers Lane from its junction with Wrington Hill to its junction with Long Lane. Wrington Hill from its junction with Ropers Lane northwards for 59m. Old Hill its entire length. Long Lane from its junction with Ropers Lane in a generally easterly direction for 922m.
