Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Highways England for M5 Junction 19 improvement works. The road closure restriction is anticipated to commence on **17 August 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is in three phases anticipated to be of approximately **2 nights** in duration for Phase One commencing **17 August 2020**, Phase Two is anticipated to be **3 nights** in duration commencing **28 September 2020** and Phase Three is anticipated to be **8 nights** in duration commencing **6 October 2020**.
