

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)
Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Whitling Street, Winford, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 7 September 2020
Ref: T20-S02

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by North Somerset Council to replace a culvert which carries a watercourse under Whitling Street. This will become operative on **7 September 2020** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **35 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Whitling Street, Winford CP, North Somerset, from property entrance to South View Farm House to property entrance to Hounsley Farm. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of works on the carriageway and will become operative on **14 September 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 nights** in duration, between 7pm and 6am.

Date coming into force: 24 September 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians the length of footpath specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for works access.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bloor Homes to development works for Bloor Homes. This will become operative on the 24th September 2020 for a maximum period of six months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 6 months in duration. Appropriate pedestrian traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Footpath LA21/31/10 from North End next to Bridge Inn to The Strawberry Line. **Alternative routes** - as signposted alongside Little River.

Listed Building Application

20/P/1898/LBC & 20/P/1896/FUH - Proposed internal and external repairs of the outbuilding which is attached to the listed building. Repairs to the roof and replacement of broken roof tiles and installation of two roof lights and window at the gable end. Replacement of the external front door. Minor repairs to existing internal staircase and floor structure and replacement of existing single glazed windows with double glazed windows at 1 Rectory Road Easton-in-Gordano.
