On 24 September 2020 North Somerset Council confirmed the above Order, made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath AX 14/21 in the Parish of Churchill within the District of North Somerset as described below: from grid ref. ST 43214 60100 south of Churchill Green, running a south, south westerly direction for approximately 236m, to Sandmead Rhyne at ST 43122 59885; to a footpath from ST 43214 60100, running in a south, south westerly direction for approximately 236m to Sandmead Rhyne at ST 43122 59885.
