

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14  
Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020  
Currells Lane, Felton, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020  
Date coming into force: 21 November 2020  
Ref: T20-534**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to clear blockages and replace BT frame and cover (contact TLU for BT 01823 661 104). This will become operative on **21 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Application in a Conservation Area**

**20/P/1829/MMA** - Minor material amendment to planning permission 18/P/4328/FUH (Single storey rear extension with balcony, cladding to front elevation and other minor alterations) to allow for increase in depth of the lower ground floor extension from 3.1m to 3.965m and replace external staircase at 67 Woodhill Road, Portishead.

**20/P/1969/FUL** - Erection of a dwelling and attached garage on site of former workshop and store. Alterations to existing vehicular access at 41 Copse Road, Clevedon.

**Application affects the Setting of a Listed Building**

**20/P/1897/FUH** - Proposed erection of two single storey side/rear extensions, raising the ridge line of the front elevation first floor gable to match the ridgeline of the existing house, installation of sun tunnels and windows to existing rear first floor bedrooms and existing kitchen, an additional rooflight to the first floor hallway, replacement of roof tiles where failing with new roof tiles at 2 Farlers End, Nailsea.
