Prohibition of vehicles over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Order 2020

Ref: WGWL/MM/19

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The effect of which is to implement a 7.5 tonne weight limit on the lengths of road described by the schedule attached.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order, together with plans of affected areas, and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order and may be inspected at www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices. Should you wish to make any observations on this proposal (whether you support or object the proposal) you should make them in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, North Somerset Council, Town Hall, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1UJ or email traffic.orders@n-somerset.gov.uk quoting the reference WGWL/MM/19 by 5pm on 25 September 2020.

Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. All representations received may be considered in public by the District Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
