Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of carriageway surfacing works and will become operative on **23 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration, between 8am and 5pm.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of carriageway surfacing works and will become operative on **23 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **4 weeks** in duration from **23 November 2020** to **18 December 2020** for 24 hours a day. **2 weeks** in duration from **4 January 2021** to **15 January 2021** for 24 hours a day. **1 week** in duration from **18 January 2021** to **22 January 2021** between 8pm and 6am.

Schedule – Stockmead, Langford from its junction with Stock Lane to approximately 30 metres in north westerly direction. Stock Lane, Langford from its junction with Bypass (A38) to its junction with Langford Road, including the roundabout.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to replace a frame and cover. This will become operative on **17 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians and cyclists the lengths of footpath specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to undertake core drilling and renew a cabinet. This will become operative on **15 December 2020** for a maximum period of **6 months**. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **3 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
