Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of carriageway resurfacing and ancillary works and will become operative on **26 October 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration between 8am and 4pm.

Schedule – Spring Hill from the junction with Wayside to junction with Church Road.
Alternative routes - Spring Hill (part unaffected), High Street, Milton Road, Baytree Road, Upper Bristol Road, Spring Hill (Part unaffected) and vice versa.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of carriageway drainage works and will become operative on **2 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **6 weeks** in duration, 24 hours a day.

Schedule – Station Road, Blagdon from its junction with High Street to its junction with Park Lane. Garston Lane, Blagdon from its junction with Station Road outside Tythe Barn to 3 Yew Tree Cottage, Garston Lane. **Alternative routes** - High Street (A368), Bath Road (A368), Church Street, Park Lane.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT for safe access to install new fibre cable. This will become operative on **8 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 night** in duration between approximately 9pm and 6am. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
